

COOKIES

Our practice website uses cookies to store only information and preferences the user has chosen. For example, if you select a specific news feed, the cookie will simply remember your choice for your next visit. It does not collect information about the user, it is only used for presentational purposes. The details are all stored in a cookie on the user's computer and not used by this practice website for any other purpose in relation to the website.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small amount of data sent to your computer or mobile phone from a website, allowing your device to return to the site at a later date

A cookie often includes a unique identifier, which is a randomly generated number. This is stored on your device's hard drive. Many cookies are automatically deleted after you finish using a website

COOKIES ARE NOT PROGRAMS AND DO NOT COLLECT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DEVICE

Cookies make your experience of using websites faster and easier. They allow websites to create a customised view of pages to which you navigate. For example, they are commonly used to authenticate or identify registered users of a website without requiring them to sign in each time they access it.

Cookies may come with or without an expiry date. Cookies without an expiry date exist until the browser is closed, while cookies with an expiry date may be stored by the device until the expiry date passes

You can restrict or block cookies set by L.L. Medical Care Ltd (Agarwal And Agrawal Practice) but this may limit your use of some functionality, such as creating a personalised account or customising the L.L. Medical Care Ltd (Agarwal And Agrawal Practice) homepage

HOW TO MANAGE YOUR COOKIES

Cookies are sent to your browser (whether you use Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Safari or any other browser) by a website and then stored in the cookies directory of your device. To check and update your cookies settings, you will need to know what browser you are using and what version of it you have. You can usually find this out by opening the browser (just as though you were going to use the internet) and then clicking on 'Help' and then 'About'. This will give you information about the browser version you are using.

To find out how to allow, block, delete and manage the cookies on all standard web browsers, go to www.aboutcookies.org and select the browser and version you are using. You'll also find information about how to delete cookies from your computer.
